### Climate Friendly Landscaping

A climate friendly garden stores more heat-trapping gases than it generates. <u>The Union of Concerned Scientists</u> suggest 5 steps:



- -minimize carbon inputs (fertilizers, electric tools
- -don't leave garden soil naked
- -plant trees and shrubs, especially native and edible species
- -compost
- -think long and hard about lawn space (convert to edibles and native plants sans grass)
